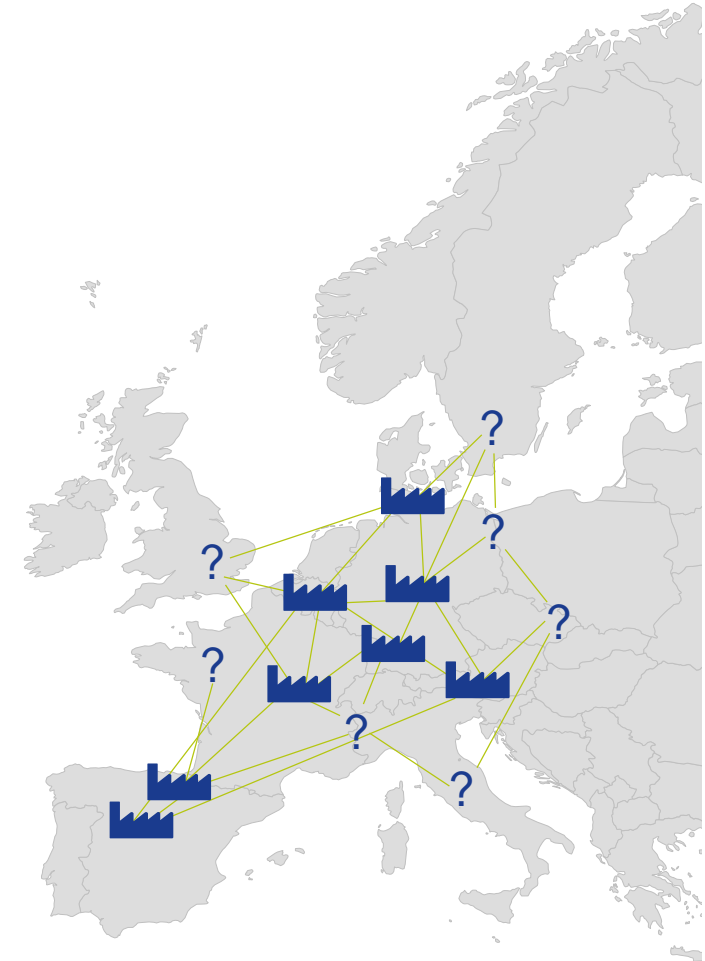

Future Outlook on the LiPLANET Network

The LiPLANET Network is at an exciting stage. With engagement from all the stakeholders, great things can be achieved:

- The Network has dedicated Expert Groups that push forward cutting edge topics in research and operation of pilot lines (e.g. operation standards)
- The European pilot lines will be connected and thus, be able to bundle their competences and tackle big tasks (from science and industry) and have an easier access to national and EU-wide calls and funding opportunities
- High-quality training programs will be developed and conducted in the different pilot lines, which will yield in highly qualified personnel establishing the large scale battery production in Europe
- The pilot lines will have a joined hot line to the EU commission to implement their recommendations on a high level
- Support of high level knowledge transfer, e.g. through conferences like the *International Battery Manufacturing Days* or the *IBPC*
